Pacific Northwest to Busan Green Corridor



- Partners: Northwest Seaport Alliance, U.S. Department of Energy and U.S. National Laboratories, Republic of Korea, Busan Port Authority
- Two Simultaneous Feasibility Studies:
 - Ro/Ro with Port of Ulsan and Tacoma
 - Containers with Port of Busan and Seattle

Pacific Northwest to Alaska Green Corridor



- Partners: 14 Corporations, Ports, Governments, NGOs, and Organizations
- Launching <u>feasibility study</u> of:
 - 4 cruise vessels
 - 120,000 tonnes Green Methanol
 - First vessel by 2032, all 4 by 2034
