| Biography | <p><b>Anders Dommestrup</b><br/><b>Head of Ports and Terminals</b><br/><b>DP World Asia Pacific &amp; Australasia</b></p> <p>Anders Dommestrup is the Head of Ports and Terminals of DP World Asia Pacific &amp; Australasia. He was most recently the CEO of DP World Korea, where he was responsible for market expansion through acquisitions and organic growth across various categories such as ports and terminals, inland logistics, and global freight. He has built a long-standing international career with experience in operations and commercial development in shipping and logistics, and has spent more than three decades managing ports and terminals in Australia, China, Hong Kong, Malaysia, the Philippines, Singapore, and the UAE.</p> <p>Anders started his career with A.P. Moller-Maersk in Copenhagen, where he ran the Maersk Sealand fleet for service calls in West Africa, the Mediterranean, and the Middle East. During his early time in Asia, he managed Maersk's feeder network &amp; intermodal operations. He then entered the terminals business when he led the acquisition for APM Terminals and directed the commencement of operations in Tanjung Pelepas. He eventually rose to senior leadership as Vice-President of Maersk Line, where he was responsible for managing the commercial operations of container activities in West and Central Asia.</p> <p>He later became Chief Operating Officer of Modern Terminals Limited in Hong Kong and subsequently, Chief Executive Officer of Victoria International Container Terminal, where he was responsible for overseeing the design and construction of the most automated terminal in Australia. At both companies, he was responsible for driving joint-venture negotiations and directing project development to maximise overall business value.</p> <p>Just prior to joining DP World, Anders was the CEO of Manila International Container Terminal. During his tenure, he spearheaded operational automation through the incorporation of Artificial Intelligence (AI) technology. He oversaw a multi-year full-terminal refurbishment while increasing workforce efficiency. Notably, Anders also worked with the Philippine government's Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases to ensure continuity of terminal operations and safeguard employee wellbeing at the height of the COVID-19 pandemic.</p> <p>Outside of work, Anders enjoys spending time with his family of five and playing golf.
